


# **DP-540 Quick Setup Guide**



#### To use the DP-540 for printing DASCOM standard 3" paper (3.125" wide), insert the second paper guide in slot 7. This will left align the roll.

In Options menu, set the "Rt. Paper Guide" setting to 7. This will insure test pages print and margins are measured correctly.

For paper rolls less than 4" wide that are not standard DASCOM rolls, consult the operators manual for more instructions on proper installation and configuration.

#### **Belt Loop Conversion**


Detach the carrying strap, thread behind and over belt, and re-attach using the two outside Velcro® pads provided.

## **Shoulder Strap Attachment**

belt loop or connected to our Shoulder Strap Accessory (PN 92886, sold separately).

> Detach the carrying strap, thread through the opening on the triangular end of the shoulder strap, and re-attach the inside Velcro® pads.
